Interview

In this section a professor or a member of the staff will look back at his/her career and elaborate upon some highlights.

Maximum amount of words: 700 + résumé + photo (with a minimum resolution of 300 DPI).

A number of standard questions that could be asked:

- Who are you?
- When and where did you graduate? (for résumé)
- What is your area of expertise? (for résumé)
- What is your current position(s)? (for résumé)
- What were your previous positions? (for résumé)
- What are your research interests?
- What are/were your ambitions?
- What would you advise students?
- Publications?
- Awards?

Any additional questions (for example, who was/is your role model) or a nice story telling by the person itself is of course welcome.

For the résumé, information should be listed in the following order:

Year start ANIOS (if applicable)
Year start AIOS (if applicable)
Year PhD (finished) (if applicable)
Year Function as specialist
Year Professor, Head of department (if applicable)
